### *Paid Fellowship Program Overview*

The Sarita and Claire Wright Lucas Foundation sponsors a summer Fellowship Program to provide Black female law students with paid summer internship opportunities in District Attorney's offices. The program accepts applications from students at ABA-accredited law schools who are interested in exploring public interest careers as Prosecutors. Fellowships offer an opportunity for substantive work in courts, including supervision, skills development, and gaining court experience.
