

CHAPTER 73-2. OUTDOOR SALES

7.100. License Required. It shall be unlawful for any person, regardless of whether that person is required to have obtained another license by the City, to sell outside that person's business establishment, whether on a public or non-public sidewalk, grassy area or in a parking area, any product or service other than what that person sells inside his/her business establishment unless that person has received from the City a license authorizing an outdoor sale of products or services other than products or services sold inside that establishment.

7.101. License Application. Any person seeking to obtain a license pursuant to this Chapter shall pay an administrative fee and file an application with the City Clerk upon forms prescribed and furnished by the Clerk.

7.102. Penalty. Violation of this Chapter is hereby designated a municipal civil infraction and a civil fine in an amount not to exceed \$500.00 plus costs shall be paid by a defendant who is found responsible for each such violation. Violators shall also be subject to sanctions, remedies and procedures as set forth in Chapter 6 of this City Code and Act No. 236 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1961, as amended.
