LOCAL LAW FILING

Local Law No. 1 of the year 2024

A local law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c (Insert Title)

Be it enacted by the Town Board (Name of Legislative Body)

County of Ontario

City Town of Geneva

as follows:

Village

Section 1: Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Geneva, County of Ontario pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the Town of Geneva to adopt a town budget for (a) town purposes (b) fire protection districts and (c) any other special or improvement district governed by the town board for the fiscal year 2024 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 2: Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the town board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the town board.

Section 3: Tax Levy Limit Override

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva, County of Ontario, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4: Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5: Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

The 9-Element Watershed Plan for Seneca and Keuka Lakes has been completed and a final report has been submitted to the NYS Department of State, which provided grant funding. The plan came in under budget so there is about \$25,000 left for projects. This is managed by a group the supervisor is a member of. Storm water and other pollution control projects are underway and planned in the watershed. Having the 9E plan adds points that improve the scores of grant applications and will inform and guide actions to protect the Seneca Lake watershed, which includes Keuka Lake.

The supervisor has been reappointed to the county Planning & Environmental Quality Committee (among other things, oversees the county landfill), and appointed to the county Ways & Means Committee. He is also chair of the county Traffic Safety Board and Alternatives to Incarceration Board, and is on the board of the Ontario County Soil & Water Conservation District

A public meeting on establishing a reuse center in Geneva will be held on February 26 at 6:30 p.m. at the Geneva Community Center, 160 Carter Road. Details to follow.

Tap Grant for sidewalks MRB did the grant application and it went out January 9, 2024.

- 17. <u>Old Business</u>. Wednesday January 31 at 4 pm at the Town Hall Cornell Professor Paul Curtis is doing a presentation on deer population analysis open to the public.
