**A Local Law to Amend a Portion of the Town of Geneva Zoning Map**

**Section 1:** Purpose: It is the purpose of this Local Law to amend the Official Zoning Map of the Town of Geneva, adopted pursuant to Section 165-5 of the Zoning Law of the Town of Geneva, relative to Tax Map No. 119.00-1-9.200 that has an address of 3700 Pre-Emption Road and is an approximately 23.21 acre parcel that abuts Pre-Emption Road (County Road 6) on the east and New York State Route 14A on the west and that currently has approximately 6.6 acres abutting Pre-Emption Road zoned in the Residential Medium Density District and the remaining approximately 16.61 acres abutting New York State Route 14A zoned in the Agricultural District.

**Section 2:** The Official Zoning Map of the Town of Geneva is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of part of said Tax Map No. 119.00-1-9.200, said part being the easterly portion thereof extending for the full width of said parcel from Pre-Emption Road (County Road 6) westerly for approximately 942.26 feet to the rear line, as extended, of the proposed Lot 2 of the Geneva General Hospital Subdivision Plan for this parcel, prepared by BME Associates, dated September 9, 2021 and being Project No. 21-0084, to now be Town Center Mixed-Use District. The rest of this parcel located west of the above-described portion shall remain zoned in the Agricultural District.

**Section 3.** If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been ordered.

**Section 4.** This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE**, that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Geneva on the 9th day of November, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., at the Geneva Town Hall, 3750 County Road 6, Geneva, New York, regarding the adoption of a Local Law, which would amend the Official Zoning Map of the Town of Geneva by changing part of the zoning district classification of a parcel of land in the Town of Geneva identified as Tax Map No. 119.00-1-9.200 with an address of 3700 Pre-Emption Road, from Residential Medium Density District and Agricultural District to Town Center Mixed-Use District, said rezoned portion of this parcel being the easterly portion thereof extending for the full width of said parcel from Pre-Emption Road (County Road 6) westerly for approximately 942.26 feet to the rear line, as extended, of the proposed Lot 2 of the Geneva General Hospital Subdivision Plan for this parcel, prepared by BME Associates, dated September 9, 2021 and being Project No. 21-0084. The rest of this parcel located west of the above-described portion shall remain zoned in the Agricultural District.

7. Section 3 Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: For federally funded projects or activities subject to Section 3 of 24 CFR Part 135 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, the Town will, to the greatest extent feasible, facilitate participation of Section 3 residents and Section 3 businesses in the procurement of goods and services pursuant to its Section 3 Participation Plan. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in local publications encouraging Section 3 participation, or direct outreach by letter or email to identified Section 3 businesses or individuals included on the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Section 3 Businesses Registry. The Town's established purchase/contracting thresholds will apply. The Town will keep documentation of Section 3 solicitation and any responses in its records.

Minority- and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Business Participation in Procurement and Contracting: In an effort to affirmatively increase procurement and contracting opportunities for minority- and women-owned business enterprises, the Town will solicit MBEs and/or WBEs as part of its procurement process, when appropriate. Solicitation may be undertaken via advertisements in minority publications or direct outreach by letter or email to identified State-certified M/WBEs, or by working with a clearinghouse such as the Syracuse Minority Business Development Center. The Town's established purchase/contracting thresholds will apply. For purposes of the above, the M/WBE must be certified by Empire State Development (ESD) through the Division of Minority and Women Business Development (DMWBD). The Town will keep documentation of M/WBE solicitation and any responses in its records.

Local Law No. 7 of the year **2021**

**A Local Law Amending Chapter 63 (Building Construction and Fire Prevention) of the Code of the Town of Geneva**

**Section 1.** Legislative Intent

The Town Board of the Town of Geneva seeks to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents by mandating energy-efficient building standards. On May 12, 2020, the 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State (2020 ECCCNY), adopted by the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council, took effect and must be complied with unless a more restrictive energy code is voluntarily adopted by a local jurisdiction. In 2019, the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) developed and published the NYStretch Energy Code 2020 (hereinafter referred to as NYStretch), a supplement to the 2020 ECCCNY, and began promoting its local adoption as a more restrictive energy code.

By Local Law 3 of 2021, the Town Board of the Town of Geneva amended Chapter 63 of the Town Code to amend the definition of "Energy Code" to be only the NYStretch. After Local Law 3 of 2021 took effect, the Town Board was notified by the New York State Office of Code Development that the Town should have adopted NYStretch as a supplement to the 2020 ECCCNY and not as a replacement to it. This proposed Local Law seeks to modify the change made to Chapter 63 of the Town Code by Local Law 3 of 2021 by amending the definition of "Energy Code" so that it clarifies that the Town will be adopting and enforcing NYStretch as a supplement to the 2020 ECCCNY.

**Section 2.** Authority

This local law is enacted pursuant to New York Energy Law §11-109(1), and Municipal Home Rule Law §10 and in accordance with the procedures detailed in Municipal Home Rule § 20.

**Section 3.** Section 63-2 (Definitions) of Chapter 63 (Building Construction and Fire Prevention) is hereby amended by repealing the definition of “Energy Code” and inserting a new definition of “Energy Code” to read as follows:

**ENERGY CODE**

The 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State as supplemented by the NYStretch Energy Code 2020, published by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority, as currently in effect and as hereafter amended from time to time.

**Section 4.** Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

**Section 5.** Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
