A local law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c

Section 1: Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that may be levied by the Town of Geneva, County of Ontario pursuant to General Municipal Law §3-c, and to allow the Town of Geneva to adopt a town budget for (a) town purposes (b) fire protection districts and (c) any other special or improvement district governed by the town board for the fiscal year 2021 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c.

#### 1.1 **Section 2: Authority**

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the town board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the town board.

Section 3: Tax Levy Limit Override

Section 4:	Severability				
If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

- Section 1. The Official Zoning Map of the Town of Geneva, adopted pursuant to Section 165-5 of the Zoning Law of the Town of Geneva, is hereby amended by changing the zoning district classification of a parcel of land located on the south side of Routes 5 & 20 (also called Canandaigua Road) in the Town of Geneva that is identified as Tax Map No. 103.00-3-45.112, from AG - Agriculture District to TC-2 – Town Center Arterial District.
- Section 2. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been ordered.
- This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Section 3.
