WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to assess the advisability of submitting a Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") application to the New York State Office of Community Renewal (the "OCR") for funding to support the construction and equipping of a manufacturing facility by CCMI, Inc. within the Town of Geneva (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Town is required to hold a public hearing to provide information to the public and to consider citizen comments regarding the CDBG program and the Project prior to submitting an application for CDBG funding; now therefore, it is

RESOLVED, that the Geneva Town Board calls for a Public Hearing for all interested parties to be heard; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Public Hearing shall be held on January 12, 2021 at 6:00 PM at the Town Hall located at 3750 County Road 6, Geneva, New York; and it is further
