UNLOCKED CAR BURGLARIES

On June 11, 2023, between midnight and 7:00am, several victims reported their unlocked cars parked overnight were trespassed into and damaged by an unknown suspect(s). Details of each incident are listed below.

23-6864	Burglary from Motor Vehicle 200 Block of Maple Hill Rd	On June 11, 2023, a victim reported a 2013 Acura RDX was parked overnight in the driveway and discovered an unknown suspect had entered the unlocked vehicle and broke off the rear-view mirror. The suspect emptied the glove box and center console. Loss is unknown.
23-6868	Criminal Damage to Property 800 Block of Greenwood Ave	On June 11, 2023, a victim reported a 2023 Acura MDX had two flat tires on the passenger side. The victim related the drivers' seat was cut. The unknown suspect emptied the glovebox on the passenger seat. Nothing missing from the vehicle. The vehicle was unlocked.
23-6874	Burglary from Motor Vehicle 900 Block of Green Bay Rd	On June 11, 2023, a victim reported three vehicles were parked on the driveway in the overnight hours and discovered all three were gone through by an unknown suspect. All vehicles were unlocked. Loss is unknown.
23-6879	Criminal Damage to Property 800 Block of Vernon Ave	On June 11, 2023, a victim reported a 2020 BMW X3 was parked overnight in the driveway and discovered the unlocked vehicle was gone through and the driver's seat was cut, and the rearview mirror was broken off.
