3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- The golf course opened for business on March 19<sup>th</sup>, which was remarkable considering how much snowfall was on the ground.
- March was well over budget in revenue and rounds.
- A La Carte grill accepted the concession agreement to provide food and beverage services for a two year term.
- The liquor licenses from the Village and the State were obtained and in hand for opening day of the restaurant.
- The new golf cart fleet has arrived, and the GPS systems have been installed.
- USB ports are available on both sides of the cart, which has been a well-liked feature of the new fleet.
- The cart path project has been delayed due to the soft turf conditions; the project will begin when the course firms up enough to hold heavy equipment.
- A question was asked if the GPS gives you distance to the middle of the green. Stella answered that the system gives measurements to the front, middle, and back pin locations.

- The Friends of the GGC had a very productive meeting last Friday. After the next Friends Board meeting, members will be prepared to start cultivating donors.
- Stella thanked Dr. Scott Shore for his over 8 years of service on the GAC.
