3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella reviewed the July financials. July was a very good month with only a few weather days that limited golf cart usage and play.
- Rounds year to date are down from due to a terrible April and early May season. Otherwise, rounds have been very strong since mid-May.
- Golf shop sales are starting to increase, and extra inventory has been hard to get which is currently limiting sales.
- There is a worldwide paper shortage which has delayed the scorecard shipment. Staff has printed temporary cards until the order arrives.
- The combination of rain and hot temperatures have been very challenging on the turfgrass conditions. Dave has done a great job fending off dollar spot disease which is common this time of year.
- Windy overnight conditions have also limited night watering requiring additional hand watering during the day.
- 31 stumps were removed from the tree removal program over the winter.
- Junior summer camps have been going very well, almost all at capacity. This is the last week for camps.
- The Wednesday twilight league had a record turnout this year and concludes for the season this week.
- Glencoe Golf Club hosted the IJGA stroke play event in early August with over 100 juniors participating.
- Academy revenue is still down from individual teaching although camp revenue will exceed budget.
- The driving range has been very busy and will finish above budgeted revenues. The grass tee has been closed at times to allow the grass to germinate and fill in.
- Friends of Glencoe Golf Club had a meeting last week and added Ellis Goodman as a new board member.
- The Friends hope to get the Village board additional information they requested with the goal of having a referendum to support the clubhouse on the April ballot.

- Friends is searching for a marketing expert to assist with the campaign before the election.
- There will be a special Committee of the Whole meeting with the Village Board in September, at the clubhouse, to update the Board and field questions.
