June 21, 2021

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The Golf Advisory Committee was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at the Glencoe Golf Club.

2. CONSIDER THE MAY 17, 2021, MEETING MINUTES

The May Golf Advisory Committee meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- May rounds were doubled from last year due to the May restrictions that were in place in 2020 that limited the capacity to 25%.
- There has been an increase in no-shows which is frustrating because we are one of the only golf courses not requiring customers to prepay. There is a 24 hour cancellation policy in place and staff will be enforcing the policy.
- Geoff Lound has announced that he will be relocating out of town which will leave a significant opening in the academy operation. A job posting is in place, but there has been no interest at this point. There is currently a shortage of viable instructors in the industry, and the timing is such that all of the decent instructors are already employed for the season. Matt Siebert offered that he might know someone who would be interested in teaching part time.
- The Centennial Golf Outing was discussed. The Committee was informed that the outing is filling up quickly and to register soon if they plan on participating. Everyone was also encouraged to sell hole sponsorships for the event.
- Heritage Oaks, Sportsman's Country Club, will be re-opening in August, with a brand new clubhouse and a full renovation of their driving range and their 18 hole course. Once they reopen, we do expect a decrease in participation.

4. OTHER BUSINESS

- The Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club met and assigned prospects to board members. Steve Santiccioli has been added to the Friends board and will be a great asset to the board.
- A question was asked about adding paddle courts to the new clubhouse design. Stella answered that unfortunately there is not enough space in the plan to add courts and we are also limited in expanding our footprint per the agreement with the Cook County Forest Preserve District.
