- The golf course was overcharged \$16,000 by the credit card processor service, this was a targeted attack on our online store by a bot resulting in thousands of denied transactions which the golf course is responsible for. Staff is working with all parties involved to receive a refund.
- Stella presented some slides and videos showing the #15 pond intake project. The project took great effort and planning from Dave Arden and his team. Thankfully everything went well and the new pipe should be operational for the next 50 years.
- Stella shared the Friends article in the Glencoe Compass which turned out well and is creating some buzz around the clubhouse project.
- Pam Kinsey the new Friends campaign director, will be contacting all Friends board members and a meeting will be set up for early April.
- Sam Segvich, Michael Racenstein and Joel Solomon have joined the Friends board.
