- The golf course remained closed in February although the indoor academy was busy.
- Expenses were on budget for the month.
- Permanent Tee Times were back on track with budget despite losing 20 players from Saturday morning.
- The new cart fleet is beginning to arrive in phases and the GPS units are scheduled to be installed next month.
- Ala Carte Grill has signed a contract to provide food and beverage services for the next two years.
- Stella informed the Committee that the new restaurant will be marketed through the website, tee time reminder emails and using the Nextdoor platform. The Committee was also asked to spread the word throughout the community.
- The golf course will open for walking on Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. The driving range will also open off mats only.
- The newly installed cart paths held up well over the winter and are in good shape for the upcoming season.
- The Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club has been meeting monthly and has received training on the "Art of the Ask" from the fundraising consultant to help solicit donations.
- The condition of the parking lot was discussed. Stella reported that the Village will be using some quick patch until a more thorough asphalt repair can take place when the asphalt plant opens later in April.
