2. CONSIDER THE APRIL 19, 2021 MEETING MINUTES

The April Golf Advisory Committee meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Dr. Scott Shore was acknowledged for his service on the Golf Advisory Committee for the past eight years.
- April was a record setting month with the most golfers on record by over 1,100 rounds.
- There have been more than 1,000 senior memberships sold through April. Many of the memberships are first time purchases by golfers that frequent other golf courses.
- Power cart rentals were above budget due to very little precipitation.
- The new GPS systems are being well received by the golfers.
- The driving range had a very successful month and remained off the mats only until the end of the month.
- A La Carte Grill has signed their two year lease and opened for business on April 1st.
- Hourly wages have been increased to compete with the \$15 minimum wage in Chicago.
- Staffing levels are at an acceptable level for the beginning of the season due to many returning employees, as well as beginning the hiring process earlier than usual during the off-season.

4. OTHER BUSINESS

- The Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club had a very productive meeting earlier today reviewing the Centennial Outing and fundraising opportunities that exist through the outing platform.
- Dr. Shore has agreed to join the Friends Civic Advisory Board.
- The Centennial Celebration Golf outing will be on August 13th with a 1:00 shotgun start followed by dinner and live entertainment.

- This Friday will be the first “giveaway day” to celebrate the Centennial. Microfiber lens cloths will be given out to all golfers that day.
