- The upcoming Bio Blitz was discussed. Stella also informed the committee that a 100-year oak tree has be salvaged on the first tee and staff hopes to find a chain saw artist to turn the trunk into a piece of art.
- The success of the 2019 permanent tee time program was discussed.
- Stella informed the committee that a portion of the entry fee from the Tri-Club Challenge will benefit the Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club.
- The Assistant in Training has received certification through the Illinois Department of Agriculture for spray applications covering both turf and aquatic areas. This mandatory testing for applicators ensures that the GGC is in compliance with all current pesticide application and safety practices as set forth by the State of Illinois.
- Stella reported that two Toro tri-plex mowers were purchased through a municipal discount program.

- Dale Thomas informed the committee that fundraising efforts for the new clubhouse are moving forward and that professional fundraisers are scheduled to be interviewed in May. He added that work is in progress with the architects to create renderings and a site plan that will be used in the fundraising efforts.
