1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The Golf Advisory Committee was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Glencoe Golf Club. The following members were present:

2. APPROVAL OF THE 2018 JULY MINUTES

The July Golf Advisory Committee meeting minutes were approved as written.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT TIME

4. MANAGERS MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella welcomed Jerry Wine to his first meeting as a member of the Golf Advisory Committee.
- Stella reviewed the financial statement for the month of July. The excellent weather conditions and record-breaking rounds played were discussed.
- The turf damage that occurred in June was discussed. The low areas that were damaged were seeded and new growth can already be seen.
- The issue with broken irrigation heads throughout the course was discussed.
- Stella informed the Committee that two pieces of maintenance equipment from Green Acres Country Club were purchased.
- The planned \$12.1 renovation project at Sportsman's Country Club was discussed.
- Stella reviewed the financial position of the course as it relates to being designated as an enterprise fund of the Village.

5. OTHER BUSINESS

- Sunset Valley's renovation was discussed and its potential impact on play.
- It was recommended that a sign is posted in the pro shop to alert golfers if there is not a beverage cart on the course.
- The shortage of maintenance and pro shop staff was discussed and the fact that it has become increasingly difficult to attract and retain seasonal staff.

- A question was asked about the capital plan for the remainder of the season. Stella explained that due to the shortage of staff not all of the planned projects will be completed. There are higher priority items related to the daily conditioning of the golf course that have to be addressed prior to addressing the capital project list.
- It was suggested that an additional woman be placed on the Golf Advisory Board.
