3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella reviewed December financials.
- The golf course was open 11 days in December recording 786 rounds which turned out to be a better month than November.
- Most other local golf courses were closed for the season which helped make December a very busy month.
- Over \$2,000 in gift cards were sold for the holidays.
- Raincheck revenue which is held in a deferred account will be recognized after January 1.
- The Glencoe Golf Academy had a great year and continues to grow in popularity.
- There is a good amount of tree trimming yet to take place but will occur weather permitting over the winter.
- A question was asked about the status of Hel's Kitchen at the golf course. Stella replied that she is working on a 1-year extension with the current owners for the 2020 season.
- Matt reviewed the World Handicapping System which has recently been rolled out in 2020. Some of the changes include daily handicap updates, a new formula for index calculations, and a decrease in the number of minimum scores needed to generate a USGA handicap.
- Campbell and Company will hold its first workshop on February 3rd in the form of a roundtable discussion for constructive feedback on the clubhouse project.

4. TEACHING STUDIO DEMO-MATT RADDE

- Matt explained the technology and teaching benefits for the newly purchased FlightScope X3 unit.
- Committee members took some time to hit balls on the simulators and have their swing explained to them as displayed by the X3 unit.
- Analytics such as club speed, ball speed, attack angle, face angle, and path were explained to the committee.
