1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

2. CONSIDER THE 2019 JANUARY MINUTES

The January Golf Advisory Committee meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella reviewed the financial statement for January and February as well as the FY19 annual summary report.
- The two page promotional piece that was placed in the Glencoe Park District summer program guide was discussed.
- Stella informed the committee that several staff members took part in CPR/AED training. It was recommended that staff follow up with counsel on potential liability issues with performing CPR/AED procedures.
- The capital projects that were completed in FY19 were reviewed.
- The NOI that was achieved last fiscal year was discussed in detail. The NOI was also compared to neighboring communities. The committee congratulated the GGC staff for a job well done in achieving a strong NOI despite the annual payment to the County.
- Stella thanked Dale Thomas for his many years of service, in several different capacities, supporting the golf course.
- Dale will remain active in his support of the GGC through his commitment to serve on the Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club board.
- It was announced that Eva Levy would be assuming the role of chairwoman of the Golf Advisory Committee starting with the April meeting.

4. OTHER BUSINESS

- A question was asked how the golf course is going to address the new rules changes. Stella replied that the top ten new rules have been posted in the

clubhouse and online. Stella was also going to follow up to see if a short seminar could be offered to review the new rules.

- A question was asked regarding the status of the new clubhouse project. Stella responded that Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club is in the process of being established as a 501c3 and that fundraising will commence this summer.
- The committee inquired on the condition of the golf course. Stella replied that the winter did very little damage due to the snow cover most of the season. The areas that were damaged last season were addressed in the fall and staff anticipates that the damaged turf will be in good condition by June.
- Stella informed the committee that tree work was performed throughout the course to address limbs and branches that may be safety hazards. The work was performed by an outside company with climbers and the branches and limbs that were dropped over the winter will be picked up in the spring by the GGC staff.
