3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella reviewed the financial report from October. October continued with record breaking rounds/revenue numbers.
- Rounds through October totaled 38,434.
- Power carts continued to be a huge revenue driver for the golf course and were available everyday throughout the month.
- Compliments were given to Dave Arden and his staff for the great work they have done as the course is in great condition despite the increase in play and cart traffic.
- Stella discussed the golf industry as a whole and how participation rates have surged throughout the country.
- Compliments were given to the pro shop staff for the hard work they did this season to operate safely and provide a great respite for golfers during the pandemic.
- The new 5-year cart fleet contract was discussed.
- The golf shop continues to remain closed maintaining a very safe environment for both employees and customers.
- Tree work has begun to address safety and playability concerns.
- Pro shop merchandise sales and the plan for next season was discussed.
- Stella reported on the Friends of the Glencoe Golf Club and announced that Joe Halwax has agreed to be a member of the Friends Board.
- Stella also provided updates on the next steps required in order to start fundraising; Village Board support and addressing the old debt of the golf course.
- A question was asked if Sportsman's golf course will reopen next year and if their reopening will impact play. Stella replied that they are on schedule and should reopen in July of 2021. The impact is hard to determine but it will be another option

for golfers in the area and it will offer a new clubhouse and golf course so it may be significant.
