The August Golf Advisory Committee meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

3. MANAGER'S MONTHLY REPORT

- Stella reviewed the August financials. July was a very good month with only a few days of limited golf cart usage and play.
- Revenues were up in every category besides academy. Another post for a full-time instructor has been placed on the PGA website.
- Rounds are up 3,000 over budget year to date. If the golf course makes budget through November, we will have over 37,500 rounds depending on the weather.
- The cart path work on #10 has started. The spoils will be used to build a look out point adjacent to the 18-tee box.
- A dead willow on 15 was removed at a cost of \$5,000.
- Camp revenue surpassed budget with over 90% of students coming from the community.
- Senior memberships sales are above budget for the year.
- Winnetka Golf Course will be closing for two years which should increase demand for golf in the area.
- We are looking for a new restaurant vendor and an RFP has been posted.
- Staff will be working on the 2023 budget for presentation at the October board meeting.

- The special Village Board, Committee of the Whole meeting, will be on October 18th at 5 pm, at the golf course. Stella indicated that she would follow up with more details as they become available.
