VILLAGE OF GLENCOE REPLACEMENT TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

Glencoe is committed to nurturing its unique landscape character. This guide is intended to summarize the Village's private property replacement tree program. Additional information can be found in Glencoe's Tree Preservation Ordinance.

Our goal is to maximize tree preservation on public and private land. However, construction can have an impact on existing trees on your property and/or the public right of way. The following outlines the process that property owners must follow when planning for construction projects.

PROCESS



Prior to construction, submit a building permit application and supporting plans for Village review and approval.



The Village will provide you with permit comments and the required tree removal deposit amount. Submit your deposit to the Village.



Before construction, tree preservation fencing must be installed, inspected and must remain in place throughout the construction project. No material or equipment storage is permitted in the fenced tree zones.



After construction is complete, install desired replacement trees and submit a landscape plan to the Village.

The Village will review your plan and visit your property to inspect the installed trees. Your deposit will be refunded in part or in full as per the tree planting reimbursement table.
