1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting of the Glencoe Human Relations Forum, held in the Village Hall Hagenah Conference Room, was called to order at 6:39 p.m. on the 16th day of March, 2011.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JANUARY 16, 2011 MEETING

The minutes of the January 16, 2011 meeting were approved.

3. DISCUSSION ON THE HRF WEBSITE

Members reviewed the Highland Park website which lists a number of community services in both Lake and Cook counties. The United Way may be able to assist in setting up the website and identifying area services to be listed. Discussion was held on the various categories of information that would be helpful to area residents. Some of the suggested areas included: Senior Citizen info, Youth info, area hospitals, health services, mental health services, schools, Joslin Center, Lynx, Home handyman services, financial assistance, religious institutions, discrimination assistance, legal aid, adult education, and transportation. This list is not all inclusive and additional services will be discussed later.

It was suggested that we include a disclaimer that the listed services are not “endorsed” by the HRF and are only listed as a service to the community.

4. DISCUSSION ON CIVILITY ORDINANCE

At the last meeting Member Schmitt offered to review other city ordinances but he was unable to attend today's meeting. The Village of Glencoe does have a newly created Open Meetings Act brochure which does list some rules of decorum for public meetings.

5. NEW MEMBER COFFEES

Chairperson Cogan has received suggestions from residents for new HRF members; however, new members must be appointed by the Village President. Discussion was held on having people interested in serving on the HRF complete applications for the Village President to review. Discussion was also held on placing an advertisement in the Glencoe Memo soliciting interested individuals. Discussion was held on holding additional new member coffees possibly in May.

6. OTHER BUSINESS

The HRF would like to host another "Glencoe's got talent" show on the 4th of July. The previous show was well received by the community and it's believed another such show would be well attended.
