IV. MEETING WITH GLENCOE PTO REPRESENTATIVES

Chair Wood welcomed Ms. Plankar and Ms. Jagher from the Glencoe Parent Teacher Organization. Ms. Plankar described the PTO and its mission to give back to the schools, community and families within District 35. Ms. Jagher described initiatives that the PTO funds, such as technology, playground equipment, educational programs (such as reading programs and authors speaking to students) and before/after school activities.

The Forum asked Ms. Plankar and Ms. Jagher to describe community issues and concerns that the PTO has observed. Ms. Plankar said that since the schools do not have kitchens, it cannot prepare meals onsite, and some parents have expressed interest in having more opportunities for students to learn about nutrition and healthy meal preparation. Ms. Jagher described the school district's social and emotional learning programs that are offered in conjunction with Family Service of Glencoe. Ms. Plankar shared information about the PTO's fundraising efforts, and Ms. Plankar and Ms. Jagher described the PTO's volunteer efforts.

V. OTHER BUSINESS

AVM Tanner shared draft logos with the Forum members and asked the members to provide feedback at a later meeting.

Member Flanagan shared information about the Glencoe Community Holiday Drive's work.

The Forum discussed inviting representatives from the Public Safety Department to the December 13 meeting.
