opportunities to promote Glencoe as a welcoming community and designing street light banners to promote inclusivity.

Following the Forum's discussion about promoting the Forum within the Community, Member Elisco shared concepts for promoting the forum and volunteer matching opportunities. Member Flanagin shared information about the Volunteer Center and its work related to volunteer matching in the New Trier Township area.
