- Name of person submitting comment (address can be provided, but is not required)
- Organization or agency person is submitting comments on behalf of, if applicable
- Topic or agenda item number of interest, or indicate if the public comment is on a matter not listed on the Commission meeting agenda

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Glencoe Council for Inclusion and Community of the Village of Glencoe conducted virtually in accordance with Governor Pritzker's Executive Order 2021-19 was called to order by the Chair Dipti Clark at 5:33 p.m. on the 1st day of September, 2021.

Prior to roll call, Chair Clark stated that pursuant to recently adopted amendments to the Illinois Open Meetings Act (OMA) included in Public Act 101-0640, the Council for Inclusion and Community was being conducted as a virtual meeting via Zoom video conferencing software. She also stated that a quorum of members of the Forum were present via remote access and that Public Safety Director Cary Lewandowski and Administrative Intern Emily Spangler were physically present at Village Hall as required by OMA.

The Budget subcommittee reviewed a draft version of the Council's CY 2022 budget proposal for the Village Board of Trustees.

Members also suggested to form a sub-committee to make biographies of Council members available on the Village of Glencoe's website.
