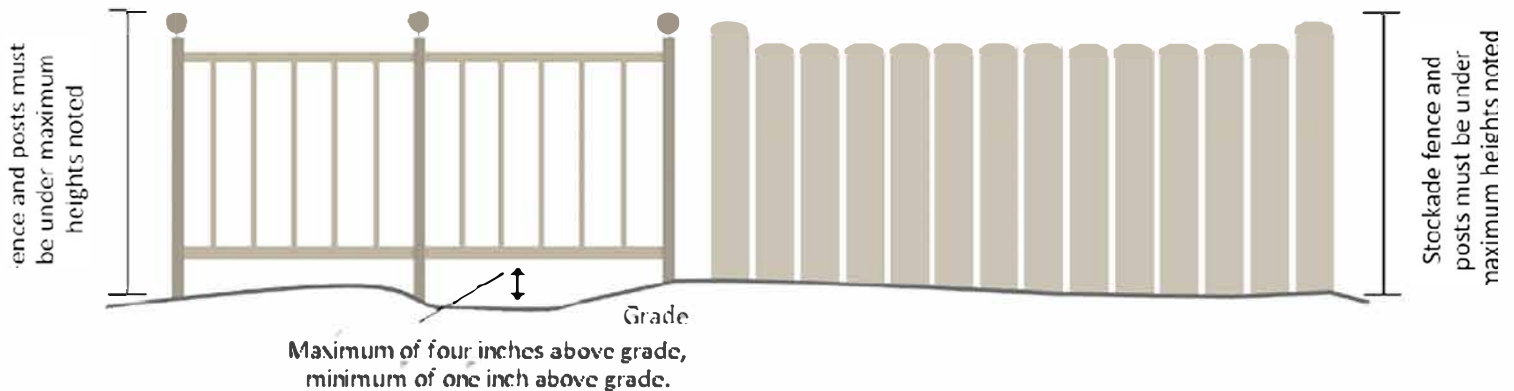

Fence Guidelines & Requirements

- Fence, wall, and column heights are measured from the ground as they follow grade.
- The property owner and contractor are responsible for verifying that all fence construction is on the owner's side of the property lot line, if necessary with the aid of a registered land surveyor.
- **The smooth/finished side of the fence is required to face outward, towards the neighbor or street.**
- The fence post extensions higher than 4 feet or 6 feet respectively noted above apply only to wood, wrought iron, aluminum or chain link fencing, but not to brick or stone walls.
- **The fence shall not impede or obstruct drainage.**

Permit Fees, Deposits, & Inspections

- The permit fee for a fence permit is typically \$100 plus a fully refundable inspection deposit. If you have a pool or electrical components on your fence, the permit fee is \$150. Additional fees for larger lots include an additional \$10 for every 50 feet over the first 500 feet in length.
- The inspection deposit typically ranges from \$500 - \$1,000 to ensure construction is consistent with the approved plans.
- **After the fence construction is complete, you are required to schedule a final inspection at www.villageofglencoe.org/inspections.**
- The homeowner and contractor are not required to be present for the inspection.
- The inspection time may vary depending on staff availability.
- Staff will follow up with the inspection result via email within 1-2 business days of the inspection.
- Deposits are scheduled to be released after you have passed your inspection.
- Please note that all deposits are required to be processed through the following month's Village Board meeting, which means that it may take up to 4-6 weeks before your deposit is mailed back to you.
