## **Tree Removal Permit Information**

There is no charge for this permit other than a tree deposit if applicable to your situation.

Identify trees to be removed with a ribbon or paint, and create a sketch below or on a separate paper.

On plat of survey or site plan above show the following:

- Tree location.
- Tree diameter measured at 54 inches above ground for trees 8 inches or greater.
- Healthy tree removal as determined by the Village Arborist are subject to a replanting deposit at the rate of \$350 per diameter inch for Heritage type trees and \$175 per diameter inch for other types of trees. Please show the location where new 3-inch + type tree(s) will be planted. Heritage type trees are: American elm, American linden, black walnut, buckeye, catalpa, gingko, hackberry, hickory, ironwood, maples (except silver and Norway), oak, Osage orange, sycamore, white pine and spruce.
- Tree removal in front yards and corner property side yards require written justification, but still may not be permitted to be removed, unless the tree is in poor health or has visible defects determined by the Village Arborist to pose a clear risk.
- The following tree removals require a permit but no justification, replacement, or tree bank contribution: dead, diseased, or hazardous trees; box elder, buckthorn (a bush), cottonwood, mulberry, poplar, tree of heaven and willow.

## IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS:

- If a tree has fallen and is on the ground, no removal permit is required
- If a tree has fallen and is lying on a house, garage, etc., a permit is obtainable after removal by sending or showing the Village a telephone/photo image of the condition that existed.
