The Harvey County Clerk / Election Office is here to serve you in any way possible. If you have any further questions, please don't hesitate to call.

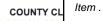

The regular meeting of the Hesston City Council was held on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. via online video meeting software. The Council Chambers / Municipal Court Building located at 110 E. Smith Street was open to the public to view and/or participate in the meeting.

Council members Larry Fuqua, Jason Jones, and Clare Moore, City Administrator Gary Emry, City Attorney J.T. Klaus, and City Clerk Jason Thrasher with Council President Susan Swartzendruber presiding. A quorum was present.

PROJECT PERFORMANCE CDBG CV3 GRANTS

Rose Mary Saunders with Ranson City Code was present to facilitate the public hearing. The floor was opened to public and council comment.

Clare Moore moved to authorize the mayor to sign the CDBG Grant closeout documents. Jason Jones seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

ORDINANCES

ORDIN ANCE NO. 180-2021-046: AGCO IRB

Larry Kleeman with Ranson City Code and Seth Beytien with AGCO were present to answer questions related to the AGCO IRB Ordinance and associated projects.

Clare Moore moved to adopt Ordinance No. 180-2021-046 which authorizes the issuance of \$4,510,000 in Industrial Revenue Bonds for AGCO. Larry Fuqua seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

ORDINANCE NO. 010-2021-225: GOLF COURSE LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Larry Fuqua moved to adopt Ordinance No. 010-2021-225 which authorizes the mayor to sign a lease purchase agreement with The Citizens State Bank to finance the purchase of 50 golf carts and other misc. equipment. Clare Moore seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH HARVEY COUNTY ERT

Clare Moore moved to authorize the mayor to sign the Emergency Response Team Mutual Aid Agreement with Harvey County. Jason Jones seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

JOB DESCRIPTION - ASSISTANT GOLF PROFESSIONAL

Clare Moore moved to approve the job description for the Assistant Golf Professional. Larry Fuqua seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

WELL #10 - REHAB

Public Works Superintendent Scott Robertson was present to brief the council on this item.

Clare Moore moved to approve the bid from Layne in the amount of \$44,061 to rehabilitate Well #10 with the funds coming from the Utility Maintenance Reserve. Jason Jones seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

2022 CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS

Larry Fuqua moved to approve the 2022 Cereal Malt Beverage Licenses for the Hesston Public Golf Course, and Casey's located at 724 E. Lincoln Blvd. and 209 S. Old 81 Hwy. Clare Moore seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

TRANSIENT GUEST TAX - ARPA FUNDING

Clare Moore moved to grant the Hesston Chamber of Commerce \$26,914 from the American Rescue Plan Funds to make up for lost revenue due to the covid pandemic. Jason Jones seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

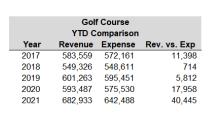
Note: The year-end transfers have not been completed yet and will be processed before we close the 2021 budget year- typically by early February.

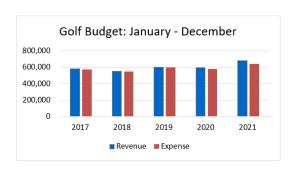
Pooled Cash and Debt (Exhibit I) – The City's total pooled cash position is approximately \$10.8 million. The City's debt of \$17.3 million is made up of five G.O. Bonds that are paid primarily through special assessments, two PBC Bonds for the library building and the recreation project, two golf grounds equipment lease-purchase, a golf cart lease-purchase and the gas utility low-interest loan.

Operating Expenses to Budget (Exhibit I) – All funds are within budget or are meeting expectations for the year. The Bond & Interest Fund is slightly over budget, which is due to the refinancing that took place this year. This fund is within budget authority as the reserves were budgeted with the State.

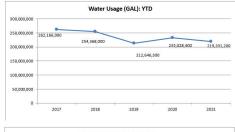
<u>The General Fund (Exhibit II)</u> – The General Fund received the final distribution of property and motor vehicle taxes for November. Expenses end the year within expectations.

Golf Fund (Exhibit III) - The following is a 5-year comparison of Golf Course budget activity:

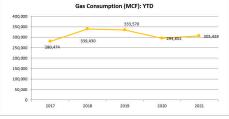


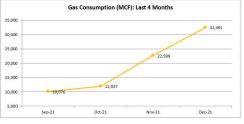


<u>Utility Operations (Exhibit IV - IX)</u> – The following graphs shows comparisons of gas and water usage year-to-date over the last 5 years. It also shows gas and water usage over the last 4 months. In September the second quarterly payment towards the State Utility Loan was made from the Gas Fund.









Economic Development & Revolving Loan (Exhibit IX) – The Revolving Loan fund has a balance of \$186,080 available for new loans. There is currently a moratorium on this program.

<u>Transient Guest Tax (Exhibit XI)</u> – The table below shows a 5-year comparison of Transient Guest Tax Fund proceeds thru November. These funds are passed the Chamber / Convention and Tourism Board.

PBC, Land Bank, Business Utility Grants (Exhibit XII) – The Business Utility Grant Fund was added to this section of the financial statements. In April 2020 the \$5K City portion of the grant was added to the fund as revenue. In May 2020 the \$5K Community Foundation grant was received. Business Utility Grant Assistance was provided in the amount of \$10,000 that went to 10 Hesston businesses.

American Rescue Plan, Community Development Block Grant (Exhibit XIII) – The City received half of the ARPA funds totaling \$283,843 in July. We received an additional \$1,688.00 in October. \$26,914 was provided to the Chamber to make up for covid related revenue loss.

The City was awarded \$150,000 in CDBG Funds to be used for covid related business grants for approved businesses. Ten businesses qualified and received funding totaling \$143,100. The balance of the \$150,000 will go towards grant administration.

Projected response revenue for 2021 was \$210,000. We collected 130% of that projection due to a significant increase in the number of billable calls.

Our uncollectible debt showed a significant increase from last year's amount that we attribute to an increase in work comp claims, bankruptcies, law enforcement negotiated claims and deceased patients with no estate write-offs.

The Kansas Set-off and the CBK collection fee was much lower this year as we are now recovering those debts with less exposure to the collection fees. CBK is recovering their collection fees from the debtor and not passing them on to us.

Blue Cross Blue Shield contractual write-off amount was comparable to the past two years.

The Medicare/Medicaid mandated write-off showed a significant increase from last year. This increase is a reflection of the increased number of billable responses with a significant percentage of them being Medicare/Medicaid claims.
