Brad Unruh moved to approve the amended Hesston Public Library / City License Agreement that defines the roles and responsibilities for the upkeep of the new library building. LuAlan Willems seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS

ORDINANCE NO. 020-2010-134

Phil Regier moved to adopt Ordinance No. 020-2010-134 that would amend Section 9-112 of Chapter IX, Article 1 of the Code of the City of Hesston to establish base court costs. John Reimer seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

CROSSING GUARD AGREEMENT WITH HESSTON AREA SENIORS

LuAlan Willems moved to adopt the proposed Crossing Guard Agreement with H.A.S. that provides for school crossing guards for two intersections at a fee of \$2,000 per intersection or a total of \$4,000. Des Martens seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

NEW BUSINESS

INTERSTATE PARK UPGRADE

Park Superintendent Ken Schwanke reviewed the bids to improve the pond at Interstate Park. It was the consensus of the Council to authorize the project to proceed under the City Administrators direction.

CONCEPT STUDIES OF LINCOLN BLVD BETWEEN PLAZA AND OLD 81 HWY

It was the consensus of the Council to direct staff to obtain traffic and drainage studies of Lincoln Blvd.

HAEDC BUDGET DISCUSSION

City Council and staff held a discussion on the proposed budget increase requested by the HAEDC with no action taken.
