NEW BUSINESS

RIDGE POINTE REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

Clare Moore moved to approve the real estate contract with option agreement that outlines the terms and conditions by which Ridge Point Properties, L.L.C. will purchase the Ridge Pointe properties from the City of Hesston. Brad Unruh seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

IRRIGATION CONTROL PANEL PURCHASE

Clare Moore moved to approve the bid from NuCo Pump in the amount of \$54,357 to purchase an irrigation control panel for the Hesston Golf Course. The payment would be made from Fund 34 - Golf Course Maintenance Reserve. Susan Swartzendruber seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

WATER TOWER EXTERIOR CLEANING

Brad Unruh moved to approve the bid from Viking Industrial Painting in the amount of \$15,800 to clean the outside of the water tower. The payment would be made from Fund 13 – Utility Maintenance Reserve. Clare Moore seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

MAIN STREET CLOSURE REQUEST

Clare Moore moved to approve the request by the Hesston Chamber of Commerce to close Main Street on Saturday, December 3rd from 2:00 p.m. until later in the evening to allow for the Holly Jolly Hesston and Holiday Tree Lighting events. Susan Swartzendruber seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
