# **Small Business Administration Economic Injury Disaster Loans**

Applicants may apply online using the Electronic Loan Application (ELA) via SBA's secure website at <a href="DisasterLoanAssistance.sba.gov/ela/s">DisasterLoanAssistance.sba.gov/ela/s</a> and should apply under SBA declaration #17536, not for the COVID-19 incident.

Disaster loan information and application forms may also be obtained by calling the SBA's Customer Service Center at 800-659-2955 (800-877-8339 for

the deaf and hard of hearing) or emailing <u>DisasterCustomerService@sba.gov</u>. Loan applications may be downloaded at <u>sba.gov/disaster</u>.

The filing deadline to return EIDL applications is April 25, 2023.
