Shop Local and Park Longer This Holiday Season!

The City of Highland Park encourages residents and visitors to shop and dine

locally this holiday season with extended parking hours in the month of November and December.

Extended parking hours:

Saturday, November 19, 2022 – Monday, January 2, 2023

Parking restrictions will be suspended at all municipal parking lots. There will be no time limit enforced at these public lots. Disabled parking, fire hydrant zones, loading zones, and on-street customer-only parking will still be in effect. Permit parking still remains in effect during these parking holidays. Employee parking restrictions will also be strictly enforced.
