

# **Sponsor-a-Planter Program**

Through the **Sponsor-a- Planter Program**, the City of Highland Park offers residents an opportunity to beautify the City's Central Business District and the Ravinia District by sponsoring one or more

available municipal planters during the summer and fall seasons.

The City will recognize sponsors on a 5" x 7" placard featured in the planter, or sponsors may choose to recognize or memorialize an individual or family. The City will also recognize sponsors on its website.



To participate, residents pay an annual fee to the City for the flower planting and maintenance as well as the addition of the 5"x7" placard for one season (May—Nov). Planting will commence upon receiving the funds.

Annual cost of a planter sponsorship, including the placard:

· Large Planter: \$750 (Central Business District Only)

Medium Planter: \$350Flower Pot: \$200

## **Bike Safety**

The City of Highland Park, in line with its Sustainability Initiatives, strives to be a city that caters to both cyclists and pedestrians. In 2018, the League of American Bicyclists designated the City of Highland Park a Bicycle Friendly Community at the Bronze level, and the City is continuing to improve in providing resources and opportunities for residents who ride or walk.



### Six Steps to Stay Safe While Biking

- 1. Always wear a helmet.
- 2. Wear bright-colored clothing to increase visibility.
- 3. Ride in a group on the right side of the road no more than two abreast with the flow of traffic.
- 4. Review your route before you ride.
- 5. Remember to stop at stop signs and obey traffic laws.
- 6. It is legal to cycle on sidewalks. When riding on the sidewalks, remember to signal by voice or bell when approaching pedestrians. **Note: In Highland Park, biking on the sidewalk within any commercial zoning district of the City is prohibited.**

The Rules of the Road apply to bicyclists, too. Brush up at **cyberdriveillinois.com**.

Safety is everyone's responsibility. Drivers should use caution and remain alert for bicyclists, especially at night.

# Financial Aid for Retailers and Restaurants Grant Program

The City of Highland Park has a matching grant program to assist restaurants and retailers with operational costs incurred to provide a safe environment for customers and staff in compliance with state and federal public health guidelines for the coronavirus pandemic. The program will accept applications from qualifying restaurants and retailers located and operating within a commercial building in Highland Park



with a net worth of less than \$2 million and generating less than an average of \$200,000 in profit per year for two years after taxes. Qualifying

restaurants and retailers may apply for reimbursement of up to 50% of eligible expenses related to COVID-19 public health mitigations, to a maximum of \$10,000 for restaurants and \$5,000 for retailers, for costs incurred between August 15, 2020, and December 31, 2021, or until funds are depleted. *More information is available here*.
