Good news for business owners and their employees who commute! Thanks to a [new law](#), the pre-tax [Transit Benefit Fare Program](#) will be expanded to more workplaces than ever before in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, and Will Counties. Starting next year, transit benefit programs offer both employers and employees savings and will help promote transit as a first choice for regional travel.

Under the program offered by the Regional Transportation Authority, full-time employees may elect to withhold up to \$300 in pre-tax wages each month to purchase transit fare – broadening their commute horizons to bus, rail, vanpool, and more. Employers who enroll in the RTA Transit Benefit Fare Program can see their first month of fees waived by using promo code **TRANSIT2024**.
