



In accordance with the statewide "stay at home" order, CPAH's physical office will be closed until further notice but we remain available to serve the community. - Lake & Cook Counties are suspending court ordered evictions and foreclosures for at least 28 days. Call your landlord or lender if you have questions.
- Properties secured by FHA-insured single family mortgages are subject to a moratorium on foreclosure for a period of 60 days. The moratorium applies to the initiation of foreclosures and to the completion of foreclosures in process.
- [Bank of America](#) is offering the ability to defer mortgage payments for those affected by the crisis.
- [ComEd](#), [North Shore Gas](#) as well as telecom companies are suspending shut offs and waiving late fees. Please check with your provider for details.
- Federal income tax filings and payments are extended to July 15th.
- Immigrant families are encouraged to seek medical treatment if necessary. COVID-19 testing, prevention and treatment cannot be used against immigrants.
- Townships are providing food and financial assistance. Please call your Township directly.
