Back by popular demand - the City of Highland Park invites the community to participate in the final call for the "Donor Brick Program" to support the Sesquicentennial Celebration in 2019. The bricks purchased through the second-round of the program will join the first round of bricks already installed at the newly named Sesquicentennial Park at the intersection of Deerfield Road, Hickory Street, and Laurel Avenue in spring of 2020.

This is a final call for this unique and timeless opportunity for recognizing individuals, schools, teams or businesses with a brick, or a series of bricks, featuring a personalized message or name. The commemorative bricks are 4" x 8" crafted with a customized message rendered in deep-relief. Each paver can be inscribed with up to 3 lines and up to 13 characters per line. Placement of bricks will be random. Cost per brick including engraving is \$150.

Second round Brick Orders are due to City Hall by November 18, 2019 at 5 PM.
