- **Illinois Lead Service Line Replacement and Notification Act (Act 102-631 formerly HB3739)**
 - Effective 1/1/2022
- **Major Elements**
 - Mandatory LSLR
 - No Partial LSLR
 - Must develop Inventory
 - Must develop Replacement Plan

City Voluntary Lead Service Line Program

- Approved effective January 1, 2022
- Reimbursement lesser of 20% of improvement cost or \$3K for short service line or \$5K for long service line
- First-come, first-served basis

Interest	1.04%
Yearly Payment	\$222,555
Loan Payment Over 20 Years	\$4,451,101
Yearly Payment for 5 Years of Replacements*	\$1,112,775

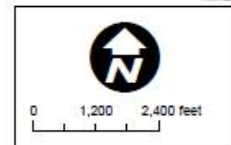
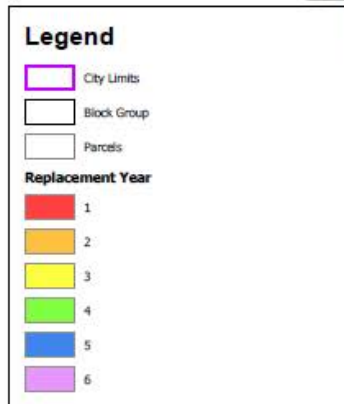
