

COVID-19 Temporary Sign Regulations

In response to COVID-19, the City of Highland Park is allowing additional temporary signage for businesses. A Temporary Sign is constructed of cloth, canvas, fabric, paper, plywood, or other light material and intended to be displayed for a short period of time. Temporary signs approved during COVID-19 for outdoor dining and business activity may be displayed through the term of your temporary outdoor expansion permit. Temporary Signs: Permit Required

Sign permits are required for the following sign structures to ensure they are installed safely and comply with applicable building code requirements. **Only 1 sign is permitted per business from the following temporary signs:**

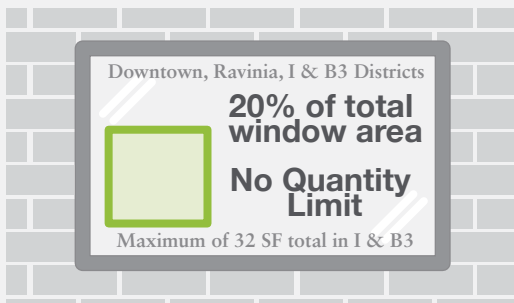

Temporary Signs: No Permit Required

The following signs do not require a permit, but must comply with the regulations below.

A-FRAME SIGN

A-Frame signs may be placed in the right-of-way but cannot obstruct foot traffic. Signs must be stored away at the close of business.

Prohibited Signs

The following signs are not permitted in any zoning district within the City of Highland Park.
