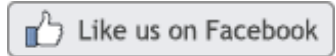
Nominations Sought for 2016 Mayor's Beautification Awards

Legal aid assistance will now be available to the local workforce

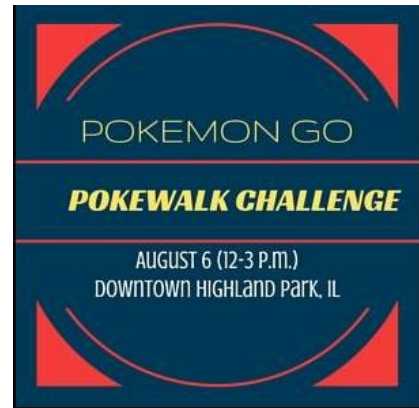
