1.0 Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this guideline is to document the apparatus numbers used by the Highland Park Fire Department and neighboring jurisdictions. (Numbers in parenthesis are the fleet numbers of the vehicles)

2.3 Station #34 - 1100 Half Day Road

2.3.1 The apparatus number of Engine #33 or Ambulance #33 will change to the Station 32 or 34 number of the vehicle it replaces when such vehicle is out of service (E-32, A-32, S-34, and A-34). Engine #33 will keep the "E-33" designation when replacing Engine #33 or Truck #33. When Engine #33 or Ambulance #33 replaces an in-service vehicle from Station #32 or Station #34 that is committed in another town or on an incident in Highland Park, then these apparatus will take the "Reserve" designation of the location where they are temporarily stationed (RE-32, RA-32, RE-34, RA-34).

3.0 Station Numbering of Automatic Aid and Neighboring Fire Departments

- 3.1 The following is a list of the station numbers that are used by neighboring departments. Their apparatus will coincide with the station number.
 - 3.1.1 Station #10 - Northbrook Fire Department

 - 3.1.2 Station #19 - Deerfield Bannockburn Fire Protection District
Station #20
 - 3.1.3 Station #26 - Wilmette Fire Department
Station #27
 - 3.1.4 Station #28 - Winnetka Fire Department
 - 3.1.5 Station #29 - Northfield Fire / Rescue Department
 - 3.1.6 Station #30 - Glencoe Department of Public Safety
 - 3.1.7 Station #1 & #2 - Lake Forest: 400 series apparatus numbers
- 3.2 With the exception of Lake Forest, all of these departments will use the same number designation for the Fire Chief (number ends in 00), Deputy Chief (number ends in 01), Battalion Station #, i.e. Battalion 33, Battalion 20, etc. There may be some changes in numbers for Fire Prevention, Mechanic, etc. and other personnel depending on the department.
- 3.3 The only time the designation "Highland Park " is used in front of the apparatus signature is when responding on Mutual Aid Box alarms.
