Under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140, I am requesting copies of public records that related to the Highland Park Police Department's 2019 encounters with Robert E. Crimo III, DOB 9/20/2000. This request includes any and all police reports related to Crimo's April 2019 suicide attempt and the department's September 2019 seizure of knives from his home following threatening statements to his family. It also includes any communications made to the Illinois State Police concerning these incidents.

I request the responsive materials be made available electronically. I understand the Act permits a public body to charge a reasonable copying fee not to exceed the actual cost of reproduction and not including the costs of any search or review of the records. 5 ILCS 140/6. However, the law allows you to impose a waiver or reduction of fees when information is sought in the public interest, as is the case for this request. I am a journalist for The Associated Press making this request for newsgathering purposes.

I look forward to hearing from you in writing within five working days, as required by the Act 5 ILCS 140(3). Thank you for considering and responding to this request.

Gavin Newsom's TV ad slamming DeSantis fills a void among Democrats

The [shooting](#) at a July Fourth parade in Illinois seemed somehow different — it wasn't just one more massacre. This was obvious to everyone, especially liberals who criticize American gun culture and the difficulty of passing legislation at the national level.

Nowhere seems safe, and politicians are unable or unwilling to do anything about it.

For those liberals, the reaction of their party's leadership, if not nearly as repugnant as the GOP's standard "thoughts and prayers, ♦ is nonetheless frustrating. Our country feels like it's spinning downward at an ever-more-furious pace, and the party is led by superannuated politicians who at these moments explain why they'd like to do more but are constrained from doing so.

So they criticize the [Supreme Court's recent ruling](#) nullifying some blue-state gun laws and tout the [new gun reforms](#), which [represent real progress](#), though not nearly enough. But few national Democrats, if

any, are making a comprehensive case that right-wing radicalization threatens a nightmarish future, on many fronts at once.

Right now, the GOP is united in its determination to put more guns on the streets. Its state legislatures compete to pass the most draconian laws on abortion they can dream up. Its witch hunt against critical race theory morphed into an anti-LGBTQ crusade. It has given itself over to deranged lies about voter fraud conspiracies, the very lies that inspired the Jan. 6, 2021, riot and threaten to make fair elections impossible.

Meanwhile, President Biden keeps talking about the Republicans of good will whose support he seeks. Democratic leaders in Congress focus on discrete pieces of legislation they hope to pass but only occasionally do.
One just doesn't get the sense that their hair is on fire, which is how rank-and-file Democrats feel.

We think this is the context for the new, much-discussed move by California Gov. Gavin Newsom (D). Over the weekend, he aired an ad on Fox News aimed ostensibly at Floridians living under Gov. Ron DeSantis, the second most important Republican in the country after Donald Trump:

“It’s Independence Day, so let’s talk about what’s going on in America, ♦ Newsom says in the ad. “Freedom is under attack ♦ in places like Florida, he says, listing a number of issues — abortion, free speech, voting rights — on which Republicans are trying to “take your freedom. ♦

The message here is that all these right-wing efforts add up to profoundly threaten the way of life that much of Blue America takes for granted. Why don’t we hear this big-picture case more often?

Yes, it’s a bid for attention. Newsom, an ambitious politician who’s likely eyeing a White House run, knows a personal spat between two governors is irresistible to political reporters.

But he’s speaking into a real vacuum. **Democratic voters crave signs that party leaders understand their frustration is bordering on panic: As they see it, the side making serious ideological gains is the opposition, whose chances of winning Congress don’t seem diminished by revelations about Trump’s GOP-enabled effort to destroy our political order, court decisions gutting long-settled rights, or mass-shooting nightmares that seem horrifyingly inevitable.**

Newsom’s foray captures a sense that a generational turn among Democrats is needed for party leaders to communicate effectively about this pileup of perils. Consider that the most viral recent moments communicating this radicalization have been staged by younger Democrats, often quite effectively.

State Sen. Mallory McMorrow of Michigan commanded far-reaching media attention by tearing into a GOP colleague for pushing the vile “groomer” ♦ smear about Democrats, linking it to a forceful critique of the right’s degradation of our national life.

Similarly, Sen. Brian Schatz (D-Hawaii) has urged Democrats to “make more noise” ♦ in response to right-wing extremism. In this telling, there’s a “loudness” ♦ gap between the parties: Democrats must sound a drumbeat of urgency, if only to let the country know something is dangerously out of control on the right.

Take the Jan. 6 committee hearings. The disarming of GOP efforts to plant saboteurs on the committee, combined with tactics such as drawing attention to Fox News personalities’ texts and telling gripping

stories about Trump's descent into madness and corruption, have focused extraordinary attention on the insurrectionist mania gripping the right and some in the GOP.

House Speaker Nancy Pelosi (D-Calif.) deserves credit for that success. But much heavy lifting is being done by Rep. Liz Cheney (R-Wyo.), the committee vice chair, and hugely compelling witnesses such as Cassidy Hutchinson. It's hard to conclude that the Democratic leadership sees a broader lesson in the success of this effort.

And as Ron Brownstein notes, the uncertain rhetorical response by Democratic leaders is joined at the hip with a seeming unwillingness to fully embrace procedural hardball. Their call for an end to the filibuster to protect democracy and abortion rights seemed belated and tentative, even as the consequences of the right's capture of the Supreme Court are rubbed in liberals' faces daily.

Democratic strategist Simon Rosenberg suggests that for Democrats to have any chance in the midterms, they must communicate with the majority that's repelled by the Trump-era GOP's excesses. **As Rosenberg tells us: "We need to remind the anti-MAGA majority, who voted in record numbers in the last two elections, that if anything, the radicalization has gotten worse.💎"**

Ask yourself this: Who is speaking to that anti-MAGA majority?

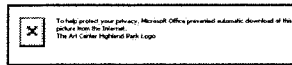

SCHNEIDER STATEMENT ON HIGHLAND PARK 4TH OF JULY SHOOTING

HIGHLAND PARK, Ill. — Congressman Brad Schneider (IL-10) released the following statement regarding the tragic shooting at the Highland Park 4th of July parade. Law enforcement has a suspect in custody.

“Yesterday, around 10:15 AM, a man on a rooftop with a “high powered rifle” shot more than 30 people at the Highland Park Independence Day Parade, murdering 7. What should have been a joyful celebration of our nation’s birth ended in mayhem and tragedy. Our community has been rocked, families have been shattered, life will forever be changed.

“I extended my sincerest condolences to the families of those murdered, and am praying for the recovery of all those wounded or injured.

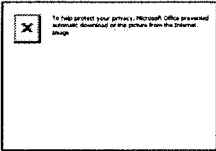
“I am grateful for the rapid response of the heroic first responders, as well as the many local residents who immediately stepped in to assist the wounded. I am thankful for law enforcement and first responders from communities in the area, the state of Illinois, and the federal government who urgently mobilized with remarkable professionalism to swiftly identify, locate, and apprehend the person of interest. I also appreciate the leadership of our Mayor Nancy Rotering, Police Chief Lou Jogmen, Fire Chief Joe Schrage, and countless others who shepherded us through the tense hours of yesterday. You all showed the power of community in the darkest of moments.

“Yesterday, our country experienced at least 4 mass shootings. We have suffered more than 300 mass shootings already this year alone (just 185 days). The nation needs to act, and act now, to save other communities from experiencing the pain Highland Park is suffering today. Most Americans agree on common-sense actions such as universal background checks and an assault weapons ban to keep our communities safe. Our community has my total commitment to do everything I can to make our children, town, and nation safer. Enough is enough.

"Highland Park is strong, and we will stand united as a community as we recover from this senseless tragedy. In time we will heal, but we will never forget. As the victims' names are identified, we will share further information with respect to their families' wishes. May the memory of the lives lost forever be a blessing.

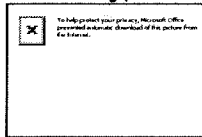

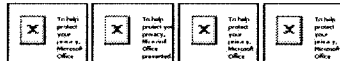

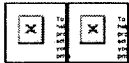

Crimo has been charged with seven counts of first-degree murder. Authorities anticipate to announce more charges in the days to come.

This update will close out the incident. Analysis is still being conducted on the incident. As this information becomes available, it will be shared with partners via our distribution list.

Information from April 2019 indicates that Crimo attempted suicide or tried to by an unknown method. The local police department went to his home a week after the attempt. It was reported that Crimo was experiencing mental health issues. Local law enforcement had not been notified of the incident until a week later, which is when they went to his home.

Information from September 2019 indicated that a family member reported that Crimo was going to kill everyone (family). The local police department removed knives and daggers from the home. There was no probable cause to arrest Crimo, no charges to file, and no complaints signed. The option to involuntarily commit Crimo was not available at that time. No information known if he had possession of weapons.

Surveillance footage from the July 4th shooting shows that a female witnessed Crimo drop something in a red blanket immediately after incident. Police want to speak to that female who is unknown at this time.

At this time, 7 people are deceased and 45 people have been injured as a result of this shooting.

The State's Attorney will hold press conference at 5:30 p.m. Central Time to possibly announce charges.

The weapons used in the shooting were purchased after the September 2019 incident; they were possibly purchased in 2020.

Crimo has been talking to investigators. He allegedly drove into Wisconsin (Madison area) and came back after the shooting.

Crimo allegedly planned the attack several weeks in advance. No motive for the attack has been developed yet. There is also no information to suggest that the attack was motivated by race, religion, or any other protective status. There are no indications that anyone else was involved.

He wore women's clothing as a disguise and blended into the crowd after allegedly attacking parade-goers from a rooftop. Crimo accessed the roof by a ladder that was affixed to the building.

Crimo legally purchased the rifle that he allegedly used during the attack. Crimo dropped the rifle after he allegedly shot and killed six people and wounded approximately 30 more people. Crimo allegedly used a high-powered rifle and shot high velocity rounds. There is no indication that the weapons were modified. The shooting appears to have been random.

Another rifle was in vehicle when Crimo was pulled over. He also has other weapons in his name that were legally purchased that were located in the residence where he was staying.

Leads and information are still being developed. Analysis is ongoing and will be provided as it becomes available.

The person of interest, Crimo, has been taken into custody.

The suspect has been identified as 22-year-old Robert "Bobby" E. Crimo III and is believed to be driving a 2010 silver Honda Fit. At this time, it is believed there is only one shooter at this time. However, this incident is still under investigation.

At 10:14am, there was a call of an active shooter received. This is currently an active incident and residents have been advised to shelter in place. The suspect is described as a male/white, age 18-20 years-old, small build, long hair, and wearing a white or blue t-shirt. A rifle has been recovered at scene. At this time, 6 people are dead and 24 have been transported. The suspect was shooting from a roof.

Several cities have Highland Park have cancelled their 4th of July festivities. These cities include Highland Park, Winnetka, Deerfield, and Glenview. This may not be a complete list.

Open sources report as many as five dead and 16 injured. Shooter is still at large. Area residents alerted.

The Statewide Terrorism & Intelligence Center has received information about an active shooter at a holiday parade in Highland Park, Illinois. Open sources are reporting that nine people have been shot. There is no information indicating a suspect(s) is in custody at this time.

This is raw reporting and the situation is rapidly evolving. Information is subject to change. Additional information will be shared as received and as is appropriate.
