Remembrance ceremony to be held in Sun Prairie for 2018 gas explosion first responders

Four without a home, one dog dead in Brown County fire

The Green Bay Metro Fire Department has given an update on the fire that took place on the 2800 Block of Conesta Drive in the Village of Bellevue. According to Lieutenant Shauna Walesh, a little after 11:15 a.m., the Green Bay Metro Fire Department received a call for a structure fire with smoke from the attic area. After arriving, firefighters confirmed the smoke coming from the attic. Crews were able to knock the fire down quickly. Although no injuries to any humans in the fire, Walesh confirms that one dog at the residence has died. All four occupants of the home will not be able to return. The cause of the fire is not yet determined and fire marshals are on the scene investigating.

Dry season brings higher fire risk over a majority of central Wisconsin

Although a majority of central Wisconsin has seen quite a bit of rainfall over the past week, much of the area is still seeing a high fire risk due to the dry climate. When land and vegetation become dry, fire and heat can spread much more quickly, causing fires to burn out of control. Jerry Minor, the Pittsville Fire Chief, says wildfires are the most common type of fire they respond to during the dry season. "Wild land fires, when it gets extremely dry we see wild land fires," said Minor, "The other thing that we have no control over are summer

storms, lightning strikes. A lightning strike to a barn is devastating almost immediately."

Smoking blamed for Janesville fire that injured 1

A fire at a home in Janesville forced three people to evacuate. The City of Janesville Fire Department responded to a home on South River Road early Friday morning around 2 a.m. where they immediately spotted a couch that was on fire. Engine 812 reportedly saw heavy fire. Nineteen firefighters got the fire under control quickly, managing to keep it contained to the first floor. However, smoke and heat damage was spotted throughout the home. Of the three adults inside, one was taken to a local hospital with burn injuries. Another went to be evaluated. No firefighters were hurt during the fire. Its origin appears to be unintentional, according to Janesville Fire Department. There is no estimate on property damage costs at this time. The City of Janesville Police and Alliant Energy helped stop the fire.

The Dodge City Police Department said the call said the bomb was located at the back of a classroom and that it would detonate in a little more than one hour. "Police Fire and EMS responded and coordinated with campus security to evacuate the area and sweep the stated location," the Dodge City PD said. This followed college administration and security requesting the area be swept by a police K-9 specialized in detecting explosives.

Firefighters who saved the historic Whiskey Row are being celebrated 'Kentucky style'

VIDEO: What better way to say 'thank you' than with a bottle of bourbon? That's what Old Forester is doing to commemorate the Firefighters who saved Whiskey Row seven years

ago. The historic block in Downtown Louisville caught fire on July 7, 2015, and was nearly destroyed. Firefighters managed to safely put out the fire while also preserving the historic façade. As Louisville Fire Chief Gregory Frederick remembers, it was not an easy task. "It was a huge challenge for us," Frederick said. "Not to mention that it was such a large area, it was almost like having two separate fires. One on Washington Street, and one on Main Street." 

PHOTOS: At 25 years old, Destin firefighter and EMT Holly Heidenreich loves the extreme life. Most recently paddling 80 miles from Bimini, Bahamas to mainland Florida with her bare hands. With her teammate, Megan Scully from Lake Worth, Fla., the women made up the only prone board paddling team for the 2022 Crossing For Cystic Fibrosis challenge. The pair completed the 80 miles in 15 hours, 38 minutes and 41 seconds. Prone paddling is different than paddleboard or kayaking. Heidenreich said the paddler is on their stomach or knees using only their arms to propel them forward. "I went on my knees and it's definitely faster, but it will wear yourself out a bit more," said Heidenreich. "I laid on my stomach for most of it just hoping for the best and kept going"

Ghana: A victim of the war ...

One of West Africa's largest economies, Ghana is battling a deepening economic crisis, with its **annual inflation rate** rising to 27.6% in May, up from 7.5% a year ago. Last Friday, following days of nationwide protests, the Ghanaian government **announced** it would approach the International Monetary Fund for financial support. The Ghanaian government has blamed the Russian invasion of Ukraine for disrupting global supply chains and leading to a surge in prices of fuel and food — both of which Ghana imports in large quantities. And the conflict is certainly contributing to the economic challenges facing ordinary Ghanaians, said consumer rights activist Kofi Kapito, in a conversation with OZY. But others believe that the war has compounded a deeper malaise afflicting the nation's finances.

The Russia-Ukraine conflict has caused energy and food prices to soar worldwide. But Zimbabwe's weak currency has made its situation especially problematic. Earlier this month, the falling Zimbabwean dollar (ZWL) caused its annualized inflation rate to jump nearly 60 percentage points to 191.6% — the **third-highest** rate globally.

"Businesses operate on borrowed funds so really with interest rates at 200% it is going to be difficult to fund their activities," said Kurai Matsheza, president of the Confederation of Zimbabwe Industries, the largest business membership organization for manufacturing firms in the country, in an interview with OZY.

Matsheza noted that, if businesses borrow at 200% interest, ultimately they will transfer the higher costs to the final consumer. "So really, it's the consumer who is going to suffer. Some businesses are going to fail to operate, and those who do operate ... will see prices

going up.”

Zimbabwe's economy is dependent on agriculture and mining, and on manufacturing firms that produce critical supplies for those sectors.

... Or the next Sri Lanka?

As with economically-troubled Sri Lanka, Ghana's struggles are rooted in deeper structural problems, according to some analysts. “The deliberate collapse of the banking system and financial institutions led to massive job cuts, industry losing capital and businesses dipping,” Ghanaian activist Bernard Momah told OZY. He was referring to **Ghana's 2017-2020 banking crisis**, when several banks struggled to meet the central bank's minimum capital requirements. Some banks failed and five were consolidated into one institution. Many companies failed to secure the capital they needed, triggering job cuts — all before COVID-19 hit, further decimating the economy. And in 2022, the government has **raised taxes**, adding to the pain for ordinary Ghanaians. Ghana's Minister of Information Kojo Opong Nkrumah did not respond to requests from OZY for a comment.

Sanctions relief for Mali

The Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) has lifted financial and economic sanctions on Mali after the country's military leaders agreed to a two-year transition of power to democratic rule. “However, the heads of state decided to maintain individual sanctions, and the suspension of Mali from ECOWAS, until the return to constitutional rule,” ECOWAS Commission President Jean-Claude Brou told reporters on Sunday. Mali's May 2021 coup d'état resulted in the deposition of the country's President Bah N'daw. ECOWAS imposed an economic embargo on Mali leading to a debt default of over \$300 million. (Source: **Reuters**)

I just ask that you keep the amount of adjusting to 14" or less. The rings have no stacking limit; however, we will only have a limited amount with us. After excavation, if the manhole surface is brick or deteriorated concrete then repair the surface with a non-shrink high strength mortar or cementitious grout to look like photo #5. We will bring the other materials needed for installing the Pro-Rings (caulk gun, knife, stringline, tape measure, and wire brush).
