



Good evening, my name is Eric Rinehart, I am the Lake County State's Attorney ... **as a resident of Highland Park MYSELF ... my family and I grieve with our neighbors over this unimaginable tragedy.**

On behalf of the SAO, I want to express my condolences to the families of those who lost their lives yesterday in this premediated and calculated attack.

Separate from those 7 lives that were ripped away, over two dozen other mothers, fathers, sons, daughter, friends, neighbors and loved ones were injured by gunfire yesterday. Hundreds if not thousands more will be psychologically scarred by yesterday's events. These individuals, Highland Park, and Lake County will not be the same.

The SAO is grateful to the courageous law enforcement officers who were there when gun shots were first fired and the numerous other law enforcement agencies from around Lake County and the State that responded to assist. Federal agencies including the FBI and ATF and US Attorneys Office have been critical partners in the investigation.

Not only did police run towards the gunshots, help the wounded, and comfort families after heartbreaking news, but they also worked tirelessly throughout the day and into the night to investigate and solve the case. In just a matter of hours, they were able to identify and apprehend the suspect. I want to also thank the community members and businesses who shared dozens of videos and photos that helped law enforcement identify the suspect.

To those who are physically and psychologically suffering today, we offer our most urgent prayers for healing – even though that feels so far away.

I know that Mayor Rotering, Highland Park Police Chief Jogmen, Lake County, and our federal partners have already started the critical work of supporting these individuals who remain in the throes of trauma. Today, our office deployed victim witness counselors and a licensed therapist to Highland Park to assist in every way possible. Dozens of private individuals have volunteered to support these families. The outpouring has been as uplifting as anything I have seen in Lake County

This loss of life, these devastating injuries, and the overwhelming psychological trauma DEMAND that we seek justice in this case and that we take broader action to protect the preciousness of life.

Today, our office has charged ROBERT CRIMO WITH SEVEN counts of FIRST-DEGREE MURDER for the killing spree that he unleashed against our community. These are just the first of many charges we will bring against him in light of the enormous damage that he has caused to so many. We anticipate dozens more charges with a set of charges for each person injured and also charges that takes into account those who were not injured.

Again, these charges would not be possible without the heroic efforts of law enforcement and the tireless efforts of the men and women of the STATE'S ATTORNEY'S OFFICE who have been working with law enforcement as soon as the suspect was identified. We continue to work with our federal partners to understand every aspect of this well-orchestrated, and carefully planned crime.

Tomorrow morning, we will bring him to a judge to ask that he be held in the LAKE COUNTY JAIL without bond on these seven murder cases.

As I mentioned, our support for the victims started today. We will guide them through the court process and even beyond as they deal with trauma that will ripple forever. But how do we make sure there are no more victims?

What should have been the celebration of the freedom, has ended in despair for our community. All the people who died, lost their freedom ... the freedom to grow old, the freedom to love, to live their lives. Their freedom matters. What are we going to do ...

Illinois has a strong red flag law that keeps communities safe and respects everyone rights. WE NEED TO VASTLY INCREASE awareness and education about Illinois firearm restraining order process. The Firearms Restraining Order (FRO) allows family/household members, and law enforcement to work with courts to temporarily remove guns and prevent the purchase of new guns by individuals who pose a significant risk of harm to themselves or others. The FRO is a civil procedure, not a criminal one. The goal is to ensure the safety of the individual and those around them.

This tool allows temporary removal of guns from the subject of the order and prohibits new purchases for the duration of the order. This creates safer circumstances for the individual to seek treatment, stabilize their behavior, or access resources to address the underlying causes of their dangerous behaviors.

Separate from the red flag laws – we should ban assault weapons in Illinois and beyond. This assault weapon ban was achieved on a bi-partisan level and with the support of law enforcement. We need to reinstate the ban on both the federal and state level.

Our Violent Crimes Unit will continue to work with all of our law enforcement partners to continue to build this case – it remains an ongoing and active investigation.

Our Victim Services Unit will be there to answer every question, every text, and every concern. We will stand with the survivors of this awful crime for as long as is necessary.


In the courtroom, we will seek the maximum sentence against this offender – not because we seek vengeance, but because justice and the healing process demands it.

As we go forward in the courtroom and in the community must do everything possible to make sure this never happens again.






