Hi everyone,

I don't even know what to write to you all at this point, but I am incredibly proud of everyone and happy you are all safe. When this occurred, I was walking in the parade, stopping at all of our CERT posts. I immediately was in full swing into locating the offender and was responsible for leading the investigation by HP and a liaison to the FBI and Lake County Major Crime Task Force. I talked with David throughout the day and informed him he would have to take charge, and he did a great job.

I understand this is a traumatic event, and I will plan a debriefing soon. I don't know when because this is a massive investigation. But I will stay in touch; please don't hesitate to use the before-mentioned resources.

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




I cannot begin to imagine the pain people are going through in Highland Park--and beyond.

### **A Message from the Village of Wilmette Regarding the Highland Park Shooting**

Yesterday, our neighbors in Highland Park experienced a horrifying tragedy, with a gunman taking the lives of multiple individuals and wounding dozens more. This occurred against the backdrop of a community celebrating Independence Day together. This event is devastating and will have a lasting impact on their community as well as our entire region.

I, along with the members of the Wilmette Village Board, want to extend our deepest sympathies to the victims and their families who are suffering and grieving. Words cannot express the sadness and despair that we feel, and our hearts go out to the victims, their families, and the community of Highland Park.

Yesterday we also witnessed first responders from across our region working together in a well-coordinated response. These joint efforts focused both on providing aid to the victims and pursuing the suspect, ultimately leading to his apprehension and arrest. We want to thank the brave and extraordinary efforts of these first responders and all those that provided aid and assistance to save

others. During times like these it is important to remember that we as a community love and care for one another and that there are individuals committed to doing all they can to keep us safe.

As details continue to emerge over the coming days, we will review and assess our policies and procedures in response to such tragic incidents. We want to assure our residents that the Wilmette Police and Fire Departments regularly work with our community partners at the Park District, Library, School Districts, private schools, and houses of worship to provide support and safety guidance for our residents. An integral part of any response is timely communications to our residents during emergency situations. We strongly urge residents to sign-up for emergency communications through [Smart911](#) through which you can receive text and phone updates as well as the [Village's E-News](#). With the many emergency sirens and helicopters heard throughout Monday, the Village used both of these communication tools to assure our residents that there was no known threat to the community.

Additionally, we have been asked by many members of our community how they can help. Highland Park will be sharing information on their [website](#) about how to donate to the victims, survivors, and the community. ### **ITC: Psychosocial training and support**

Horrific shooting incident on nation's celebration day in Highland Park, IL deeply shocked the whole community— the ripple effect of this horrific incident impacts many in different ways. For many individuals and families this event will remain a traumatic experience of their life for long time and the community will need some time to recover as well.

Over the next few days, the response, both operational and psychosocial, will transition from the immediate phase to providing a mid to long-term response, requiring comprehensive coordination, deliberate planning of emotional support provision to various circles of impact along the timeline, including identification of needs for these phases and availability of recourses.

In light of the reality described above, and based on our experience in supporting the psycho-social response to multiple incidents in Israel and around the world, the following steps are recommended:

- Identification, mapping and scoping of needs of different groups of people impacted by the incident in various intensity (families that lost their loved ones, survivors, parents/children of missing and dead, community institutions such as schools, first responders and care-providers etc.) including the projection of those needs' development along time, including various time marks (end of forensic procedures, funerals, back to school, holidays and so on).
- Identification, mapping and scoping of psycho-social support recourses (it should be kept in mind that such a transition also comes with withdrawal of "helping hands" that will be so useful during the first days and gradual decrease in availability of outside help. Also the initial response always characterized by certain level of duplications and deficits as one, due to the fact that multiple organizations are "jumping in" to help, not always in most coordinated way.
- Development of mid and long term, detailed and coordinated plan for prolonged psycho-social response, based on development of common language, utilizing all available community recourses (not only mental health professionals), progressing from short-term interventions, targeting acute trauma to full rehabilitation, focusing on It on strength and resilience of the community and its members.

From our perspective and experience, the recommended way to deal with these challenges is via a comprehensive systematic community approach that enables all the local agencies and stakeholders, formal and informal, to share their knowledge and resources and integrate their actions in favour of the community so that a continuum of care can be created in a shared language and culture of services.



ITC is capable and willing to share our expertise and experience in psycho-social response following traumatic events (by conducting online and offline training sessions) on following topics:

- Augmentation of local experts' capacity in trauma focused care for individuals, families and groups including but not limited to -
  - **Tools for provision of non-stigmatized direct care from the acute phase onwards, for individuals and families.**
  - Diagnosis, triage and initial intervention principles, models and modules for Acute Stress Reaction (ASR) / Acute Stress Disorder (ASD) as well as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)
  - Trauma focused evidence based techniques
  - Practical skills on psycho-social interventions in traumatic stress situations
  - Identification, mitigation and management of compassion fatigue and burn-out symptoms amongst first responders and care providers
  - **Treating grief and bereavement**
  - **Development of a continuum of services to deal with psycho-trauma and rehabilitation.**
  
- Support in development of community resilience restoration plan, empowering and training the formal and informal leadership and professional services in the areas of health, welfare, education and community (including faith leaders) as well as local NGOs by training trainers and creating a cascade model of providing psycho education.
  
- Development and implementation of non-stigmatized emotional support mechanism and language to address the well being of first responders and care providers, that were and still are involved in incident, focusing on mitigation and decrease of burn-out and compassion fatigue levels among those.



## Normative reactions to traumatic events

Following any traumatic event, that shatters one's routine and beliefs in life, it is natural to experience stress reactions that may feel different or more powerful than in everyday life  
*Normal reactions to an abnormal situation*



## Stress reactions can include-


- Intrusive thoughts and images, nightmares or flashbacks of the event.
- Emotional and physical reactions to the event while awake or dreaming.
- Avoidance and withdrawal, feelings of detachment and estrangement, loss of appetite, depression.
- Physical arousal, irritability or outbursts of anger, difficulty falling or staying asleep.

## Circles of Impact

In this kind of a crisis, there are various circles of impact, where the most vulnerable/affected persons are the ones most directly exposed.



## How to help children cope with grief and stress?

- Tell the truth about what happened.
- Be prepared for a variety of emotional responses.
- Be aware that your reactions and coping methods can be a model for your child.
- Help the child name their emotions and ensure them it's ok to feel this way.
- Be comfortable saying, "I don't know."
- Let the child grieve in his or her own way.
- Use relaxation techniques.



## Parents: how to recognize signs of distress in your child?

- Regressive behaviors such as: clinging, crying, bed-wetting, thumb-sucking.
- Aggressive behaviors such as: anger, risk-taking, impulsiveness.
- Avoidant behaviors such as: isolation.

*Children usually react to the emotions of the adult around them. their reactions may vary in accordance to their age and stage of development*

## Reach out for professional help if...

- Symptoms of stress as a result of for help.
- The first 48 hours might be shocking, and any symptoms you may experience would be normal.
- If the symptoms last over a month following the event, please reach out to a professional for help.
