Good afternoon colleagues,

I hope you and your family are doing well. As you likely know, earlier this month Governor Pritzker released a five-phased plan to reopen Illinois. The full plan and how it impacts our community and the State can be found on our website. We are releasing this afternoon industry-specific guidelines, developed by the State, to allow for a safe re-opening of businesses as the state progresses into the next phase of the Restore Illinois plan, Phase 3. This phase is expected to see many businesses reopen across the state.

The purpose of the draft Plan is to identify initiatives underway and planned for reopening City buildings when it is deemed appropriate. We will continue to promote the services and programs that are available via on-line or mail.

We are planning to present the City's draft Reopening Plan at Tuesday's Committee of the Whole meeting. Special thanks to all supervisors for your review and input in the Plan. Although this Plan applies to all departments, individual plans setting forth additional guidance and regulations for each department and public building are also being drafted.
