## RESOLUTON NO. 5943 CONTINUING THE TRANSPORTATION PLAN PURSUANT TO THE REBUILD ALABAMA ACT

WHEREAS, the Alabama legislature in Act. No. 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act which provides for an allocation among the municipalities of the State on the basis of the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the State a portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the municipal governing body of the City of Hueytown shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31 which shall provide a detailed list of projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year and shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund in which the additional revenue is deposited during the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Act further provides that any such funds shall be used only for the maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of roads and bridges maintained by the City of Hueytown and such other uses as are defined in the Act.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the City Council of the City of Hueytown estimates that its anticipated allocation from the Rebuild Alabama Act fund, as informed from the State, for the first fiscal year will be approximately \$127,979.00, with increasing allocations for each fiscal year thereafter.

WHEREAS, the City of Hueytown has received \$41,950.93 as of July 31, 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by** the City Council of the City of Hueytown as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to the Act, the City anticipates expending funds received pursuant to the Act, in part or in whole, to fund any of the following listed projects:
  - (a) Deposit Funds in separate account to fund road projects in 2022.
  - (b) Continue to develop a database of City-maintained roads and a Scoring System (condition rating) of their condition.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to post a copy of this Resolution as its Transportation Plan in a conspicuous place at the City Street Department, City Hall, City Library, and also on the website of the City of Hueytown.
- 3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to necessary actions to comply with the Act reporting requirements.
