



## 2023 - 2024 Parkway Tree Pruning Operation



The Village of Huntley Parkway Tree Pruning Operation will be in your subdivision. Please note the exact timing of pruning operations for your particular street will vary and schedule can change due to weather conditions.

The primary objective of the pruning operations is to provide safe passage for our road network travelers and our Public Works operations. This will be accomplished by the mitigation of sight distance hazards at intersections where traffic and street signage can become difficult to see, as well as maintaining adequate vertical roadway and sidewalk clearances. A general guideline is a minimum of twelve feet (12') above traveled pavement or curb of a public street and cited in the Village of Huntley Land Use Ordinance (Chapter 155.032 Parkway Maintenance) and the Tree Preservation Ordinance (Article XIV, Required Pruning). Proper discretion will be used in determining the actual pruning heights, keeping in mind the growth habits of the tree while also maintaining a well-shaped appearance.

Please note if the tree has Holiday decorations the Village will skip over your tree, will not trim and make note of the current condition of the tree, and will return later if necessary. Also, see the Village Website for daily updates and progress of Tree Pruning Program at the following URL:
