## Construction Underway in Downtown Huntley

Berger Excavating has been contracted by the Village of Huntley to complete water main and sanitary sewer improvements in the downtown area. The project includes replacing or improving existing water and sewer utilities in advance of the Downtown Streetscape Improvement project. This phase of the overall Downtown Improvements project began on March 16th and is expected to be substantially complete by May 15th. Please keep in mind this is the first phase of the overall Downtown Improvements project that is anticipated to be on-going through October 2015.

Residents will also see changes to the downtown parking situation. On April 7th, the westernmost public parking lot (Main St. and rail road tracks) was closed for renovations. A new temporary parking lot is now open directly behind the Parkside and Village Inn. Please access this lot from the driveway directly west of the Parkside entrance. There is also public parking available in the lot next to the Chamber of Commerce offices on Coral Street, and many on-street parking spaces.

## Curbside Tree Branch Pick Up

The Public Works Department will be conducting its semi-annual curbside tree branch pickup in May. The dates for pickup are divided into 2 regions:

**Week of May 4th - all roads north of Kreutzer Road**  
**Week of May 11th - all roads in Sun City**

Please place tree branches on the parkway by **Monday morning** during your collection week. Branch collection crews will make one pass in each neighborhood. Residents that miss the curbside pickup can make arrangements with their waste hauler, or a Saturday one time only drop off is scheduled for May 16th at Public Works located on Donald Drive from 8:00 a.m. to Noon.

**The following will NOT be accepted:** Tree limbs larger than 10" in diameter or smaller than 1/2" in diameter; Tied bundles of branches; Bagged material or material in cans; Leaves and yard waste; Trimmings from bushes; Evergreen material; Stumps of any kind. ## Local Election Update

The Consolidated Election was held on April 7th, and the results indicate two incumbent trustees and one new trustee will be seated on the Village Board in May. Trustee Harry Leopold has served on the Village Board since 2003. Trustee Niko Kanakaris has served on the Village Board since 2007. Tim Hoeft will be Huntley's newest member of the Village Board and will replace interim Trustee Charles Huffman. The Board of Trustees functions as the legislative branch of the Village government and is the elected representation of the citizens of Huntley.

- ◆ **Electronics Recycling** The Village will be accepting your unwanted electronics and batteries at the Municipal Complex parking lot.
- ◆ **Spring Cleaning Drop Off** Clean out your basement/garage and drop off items at the dumpsters located at Public Works on East Main Street & Donald Drive.
- ◆ **Paper/Document Destruction** AMS Store and Shred will be accepting documents for shredding at the Municipal Complex parking lot. Participants will receive a certificate of destruction for materials taken to be destroyed.
- ◆ **Polystyrene Foam #6** Dart Container Corporation will be on hand in the Municipal Complex parking lot to collect clean polystyrene plates, cups, clamshell containers, and block Styrofoam: NO peanuts or bubble wrap.
- ◆ **Take a tour of the West Wastewater Treatment Plant** West Main Street off of Kreutzer Road, between 9am - 1pm (tours take approximately 1 hour - last tour begins at Noon).
- ◆ **Culver's Kids Arbor Day Coloring Contest** Kids be sure to pick up a coloring sheet at Culver's, Huntley Village Hall, Huntley Library or Huntley Park District from April 6th - 26th and bring your best coloring work back to Culver's of Huntley between April 20th & 25th to get a free scoop! (no purchase necessary). Children who participate in this event will also have their name entered to win a free tree.
