

TOUCH-A-TRUCK EVENT

Village of Huntley Public Works will host a Touch-a-Truck event at the Farmers Market in the Town Square on July 24 from 8am-1pm. The Public Works team welcomes the community for an inside look at the skills, tools and equipment required to service the Village. Staff will also be available to answer questions on the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) NPDES Phase II program.

The Village of Huntley's annual mosquito control program is underway, with one application already completed. Clarke provides services that prevent mosquito breeding and suppress mosquito populations, including those that carry mosquito-borne disease. Prior to registering any product, including the Duet product used by Clarke, the EPA evaluates the product thoroughly. Duet has passed rigorous tests required by the EPA and has been approved for public health mosquito control and registered for use by the U.S. EPA in 1995. Duet is applied at extremely low dosage rates - less than an ounce per acre during the overnight hours. The spray (mist) dissipates quickly through the treatment area within 5 to 30 minutes, depending on weather conditions. Duet is applied in small droplets, which break down quickly in the environment. Since the product must hit a mosquito while it is in flight to have an effect, it is sprayed at night when mosquitoes are actively flying. You can also help fight the mosquito population by eliminating standing water on your property. To get text or email notifications on spraying in your neighborhood, please visit Clarke

FROM THE HUNTLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT JULY IS NATIONAL VEHICLE THEFT PREVENTION MONTH

Americans spend hard-earned money on vehicles - vehicles that transport families to sporting events, workers to jobs, kids to school and so much more. Unfortunately, in 2019 alone, nearly three quarters of a million vehicles were stolen in the United States, costing vehicle owners more than \$6 billion. The month of July marks National Vehicle Theft Prevention Month. Vehicle theft is serious business.

In the United States in 2019:

- Only 56.1% of all stolen motor vehicles were recovered.
- Of all motor vehicles stolen, 74.5% were passenger vehicles.
- There were 721,885 motor vehicles stolen.
- A motor vehicle was stolen every 43.8 seconds.

· Do not leave the area while your vehicle is running

As a driver, you can take steps to keep your vehicle and belongings safe. Here are ways you can help prevent motor vehicle theft: · Do not leave your keys in your vehicle

- Park in well-lit areas
- Close and lock all windows and doors when you park
- Put away your valuables

We also recommend all residents practice the **9PM Routine** – making a habit of securing your house, vehicle and belongings every night at 9. Remove all valuables from your vehicles and lock it up, ensuring that you do not leave the keys/fob and garage door opener in the vehicle; close and secure your garage door; and check that your house doors and windows are locked. Officers conducting neighborhood patrols look for open doors and unsecured vehicles at night. They will try to contact the homeowner to rectify the situation or will leave a curtesy notice to remind them of the risk of unsecured property.
