

HHS Summer Forum Information

All registration and release forms must be filled out and signed for enrollment.

We would like to welcome your teen to the annual HHS Summer Forum! Our scheduled activities and discussions are designed to help your teen gain knowledgeable information on what they may encounter in high school. These helpful tools and discussions will help your teen transition into a high school atmosphere while being better informed and educated.

Costs?

- There are NO fees or costs that are needed for enrollment. All meals and materials will be provided by the Huntley Police Department.

Lunch

- Lunch will be provided by the Huntley Police Department.
- Each day, there will be food catered by a different food establishment from the Huntley area.
- Water will be provided with lunch.
- If your teen has special dietary or food allergy needs, feel free to provide a lunch from home. Please note that there is NOT a refrigeration unit available on site and minimal space in the coolers.

Drop Off and Pick Up

- Attendees need to be dropped off at Huntley High School at 8:30 am on the first day for registration. On Wednesday and Thursday, attendees can be dropped off at 9:00 am and picked up at 3:00 pm.
- We will be located near the bus lot by door 27
- In the case of inclement weather, see below.

Weather Conditions

- We will be outdoors for the majority of the time.
- If inclement presents itself, HHS Summer Forum will NOT be canceled due to poor weather.
- In the case of inclement weather conditions or extreme heat, we will move inside

Attire

- We will be outside, so have your child dress appropriately for the weather conditions that day.
- For some activities, attendees may be required to sit in the grass.

- A majority of activities will be in direct sunlight and/or shady areas, depending on the weather. Sunscreen is NOT provided, but your child may bring their own if they wish.
- Bug spray is recommended.
- WARNING: On the last day of HHS Summer Forum, attendees will be using permanent tie-dyeing materials to make tie-dyed t-shirts. The tie-dyeing liquids do permanently stain clothing. Please have your teen dress in appropriate clothing/shoes, knowing that they may get stained.

Personal Items

- All personal items brought to HHS Summer Forum are your teen's responsibility.
- There are no lockers or a secure lock up facility for your teen's belongings.
