## **Huntley Police Department Releases Thanksgiving Enforcement Numbers**

**Huntley, IL** – The Huntley Police Department conducted a traffic safety campaign Nov. 18-28 reminding motorists to buckle up and drive sober. The “Click It or Ticket” and “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” mobilization was conducted by Huntley Police and other state and local law enforcement agencies across Illinois to reduce highway fatalities.

During the campaign, Huntley Police Department issued:

- **4** speeding citations
- **4** expired license plate citations
- **2** disobeying traffic control device citations
- **2** uninsured motorists citations
- **2** failure to signal while changing lanes citations

The Thanksgiving enforcement effort is made possible by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the statewide “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” campaigns.
